**St. John's Pastoral Care**



St. John's Pastoral Care Ministers bring the Liturgy of the Word, The Eucharist, Prayer, and community to the sick and homebound members of the parish.

Pastoral Care is a ministry of Presence and Prayer.

- The sick are physically separated from the Mass - the sacred meal and worship that is central, to the life of the parish.
- By bringing the Liturgy of the Word, The Eucharist and ourselves to them, we keep them physically connected to the life of the parish.
- Our presence and prayer bring them the spiritual and physical healing grace of God.
- We share information about the services of the parish.

Every Sunday and Tuesday mornings, St. John's Pastoral Care ministers bring the Eucharist to about 100 sick and homebound members who cannot attend Mass. It is a wonderful service - keeping those parishioners connected to the parish community.

Any of our Pastoral Care Ministers will tell you that it is a tremendous joy to bring or Lord to these homebound members. The satisfaction of bringing the Eucharist is a true healing gift. The recipients are overjoyed to be remembered by their fellow parishioners.

There are two Pastoral Care Groups, one visits on Tuesdays the other visits on Sundays. If you or a family member wishes to receive visits from Pastoral Care, please call the parish office.
