DIVINE MERCY MINISTRIES

JESUS INVITES YOU

A Message of love...

The message of Divine Mercy is that God loves us – all of us. Divine Mercy is rooted in Scripture and reminds us that God is merciful and forgiving and that we, too, must show mercy and forgiveness in our lives.

Sister Faustina (now St Faustina) received extraordinary revelations from our Lord Jesus. Jesus asked Sr. Faustina to record these experiences, which she compiled into notebooks, and the words contained within are God's loving message of Divine Mercy.

Jesus wished to save sinful humanity through Mercy, so he dictated the chaplet of the Divine Mercy prayer to Sister Faustina as a prayer to appease the divine wrath, and he also asked her to have an image painted according to the image he revealed to her, with the signature: Jesus, I Trust in You

A “Cenacle” is one element of our Divine Mercy Ministries

A cenacle is a small faith-sharing group. Our Divine Mercy Cenacle group was formed to follow the Eucharistic Apostles of Divine Mercy (EADM), and to focus on the message of Divine Mercy as found in Sacred Scripture, the Catechism of the Catholic Church and the Diary of St. Faustina, with a special emphasis on the Eucharist. This cenacle will draw you into a Divine Mercy way of life as you experience the splendor of our Catholic Faith by:

- Bringing the hurting world the Divine Mercy message & devotion;
- Professing and proclaiming the truth of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist;
- Praying together, especially for vocations and the end to abortion;
- Exercising our Faith through the spiritual and corporal works of mercy in rural Sacramento County.
